

Lesson Cycle (5E Model)

**Lesson Title/Topic:** Growth Mindset

**Standards:** 127.3.(c)(3)

<p><b>Lesson Objectives:</b> The student will complete a poster comparing a growth mindset vs. a fixed mindset.</p>	<p><b>Assessment (Evaluate):</b> Completed poster comparing a growth mindset vs. a fixed mindset.</p>
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**Materials:** Drawing paper, pencil, colored pencils and markers

<b>The teacher will:</b>	<b>The student will:</b>
<p><b>Focus (Engage):</b> The teacher will show a video introducing growth mindset.  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=px9CzSZsa0Y">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=px9CzSZsa0Y</a></p>	<p>The students will watch the video.</p>
<p><b>Teacher Input (Explain &amp; Elaborate):</b> The teacher will guide students through PowerPoint slides on Growth Mindset.  <a href="#">Green Revolution.pptx</a>                      The teacher will discuss growth mindset vs. fixed mindset, asking students for examples. The teacher will give examples of famous failures and how a growth mindset led to success.</p>	<p>The students will view PowerPoint participate in the discussion by giving examples and asking/answering questions.</p>
<p><b>Guided Practice (Explore):</b> The teacher will demonstrate a poster on the board with an example of a fixed mindset statement with a picture on half of the paper and a growth mindset statement with a picture on the other half of the paper. The teacher will ask students questions for understanding.</p>	<p>The students will watch the demonstration, asking/answering questions for clarification.</p>
<p><b>Independent Practice (Evaluate):</b> The teacher will have the students pick up papers and supply boxes and complete their posters. The teacher will monitor students, asking and answering questions for understanding.</p>	<p>The students will complete their poster with a fixed mindset statement and picture on half of the paper and a growth mindset statement and picture on the other half of the paper.</p>
<p><b>Closure:</b> The teacher will ask students for a growth mindset they can use today to be successful in school.</p>	<p>The students will respond with a growth mindset they can use today to be successful in school.</p>

<b>Options:</b>
